CONSENT ORDER

Claimant Jodi Andrews-Cade filed a petition for alternate medical care on February 4, 2019 alleging the defendants have not authorized a referral for a second orthopedic referral for claimant's back. Defendants authorized physician, Todd Wenck, M.D. who referred claimant to Myles Luszczuk, D.O.


An alternate care hearing was scheduled for February 12, 2019. Participating in the hearing was attorney Nicholas Shaul for the claimant and Julie Burger for the defendants. No testimony from the claimant or witness was taken.

Claimant's attorney stated that defendants authorized Dr. Luszczuk; however, Dr. Luszczuk did not want to treat claimant.

The parties agreed that claimant should have a second orthopedic opinion concerning her back condition.

Therefore, upon agreement of the parties, the defendants are ordered to provide a referral for a second orthopedic opinion as soon as practicable.
